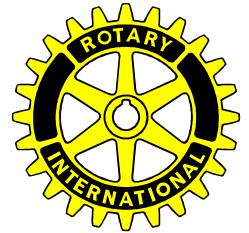

Please join us for this family event on the shore of Lake Ontario. Corn and hot dogs will be served at 6:30 p.m. Pop and water will be available, **but** BYOB. Also, bring a lawn chair and a sweater or jacket. The lake is warm enough for swimming if you are brave. If you can help husk corn, please come at 5:00 p.m.

Directions:

At the stoplights at Toronto Road and Ridout Street in the west end of Port Hope, go west through the stoplights onto Ridout Street. There is car repair business on one corner and the Winchester Arms Restaurant on the other corner. Ridout changes into the Lakeshore Road which goes out of town. Drive about 5 km from the stoplights. You will go down a steep hill into the hamlet of Port Britain. There are several houses in the village. Just past the start of the steel guard rail near the bridge, turn left (south) onto Port Britain Road and travel approximately 0.6 km. As you come over a rise you can see

Lake Ontario. Our house is Number 1030, a brown brick house on the right side of Port Britain Road. Turn around at the end of the road near the lake and park on Port Britain Road facing north. There is a laneway in front of the house, but with the wet weather the grass is softer than normal so please do not park on the grass.
