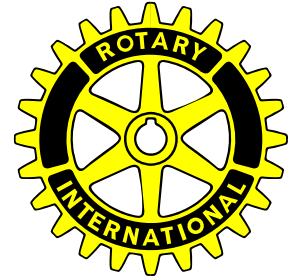

Jan reminded everyone of the membership open house night on Thursday.

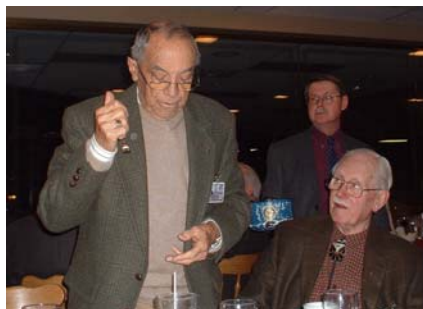
